INTERNATIONAL (NYPi)

Nanyang Polytechnic International (NYPi) is committed to enhancing NYP's reputation in the area of technical and vocational education and training (TVET) beyond Singapore. Apart from offering manpower development programmes for overseas professionals, NYPi also assists in strengthening NYP's international partnerships and collaborations, as well as in creating more international exchange and attachment opportunities for students and staff.

In FY2010/11, NYPi organised a total of 92 courses and seminars for 2,200 participants from Bhutan, the People's Republic of China (PRC), the Philippines, Sri Lanka and Vietnam.

The key programmes included:

HEALTHCARE TRAINING PROGRAMMES FOR VIETNAM AND BHUTAN

- NYP's School of Health Sciences (SHS) conducted seven courses for 125 participants from Ho Chi Minh City and Hanoi under this programme, which culminated in May 2010. The courses covered Nursing Management, Nursing Pedagogy and Paediatric, Emergency, Surgical and Critical Care Nursing.
- Ninety-four nursing professionals and administrators from Bhutan's Ministry of Health, hospitals and nursing training institutions will undergo training in NYP in five areas of nursing. Starting in January 2011, SHS conducted three courses in Nursing Management, and Emergency and Critical Care Nursing. Two more courses in Nursing Pedagogy and Paediatric Nursing are slated to run in September 2011.

PRC MINISTRY OF EDUCATION PRINCIPAL PROGRAMME

In collaboration with the PRC Ministry of Education, a special course was organised in May 2010 for 22 principals from 20 colleges and technical institutions from all over China. The participating institutions came from the provinces of Guizhou, Hainan, Sichuan, Yunnan and the cities of Beijing and Chongqing.

SPECIALIST TEACHERS TRAINING PROGRAMMES FOR PRO

In collaboration with the Jiangsu and Liaoning provincial Departments of Education in China, six courses for specialist teachers were conducted for 162 PRC teachers in three specialisation areas, namely: Computer Numerical Control Technology, Mechatronics Engineering and Embedded Technology Engineering.

TVET PROGRAMMES FOR CHINA AND THE PHILIPPINES

- A one-year TVET Programme for Liaoning Province, China, which started in July 2009, was successfully completed in November 2010 with a total of 180 participants. In this programme, 86 senior management officers and 94 specialist teachers completed seven courses in TVET Management, Computer Numerical Control Technology and Mechatronics Engineering.
- The TVET Programme for China's Guangdong Province began in February 2011 with 16 principals who attended the NYP TVET Management Programme. Over the next one and half years, a total of 224 TVET Senior Officials, Principals, Heads of Department and Specialist Teachers will attend a series of training programmes ranging from one to six weeks at NYP.

The TVET Programme for Sichuan Province began in March 2011 with 17 Senior Officials and 49 Principals who attended the NYP TVET Management Programme. Over the next two years, a total of 230 TVET Senior Officials, Principals, Heads of Department and Specialist Course Managers will attend a series of training programmes ranging from one to three weeks at NYP.

Some 176 Philippines' TVET Officials, Principals, Heads of Department and Specialist Teachers from 31 Public Higher Education Institutes (PHEIs) attended eight TVET courses in NYP from January to November 2010. Of these, 80 Senior Officials, Principals and Heads of Department completed NYP's TVET Management course, while 96 Specialist Teachers completed courses in Mechatronics and Industrial Electronics.

MANAGEMENT & DEVELOPMENT OF COMPETENCY-BASED TRAINING PROGRAMME FOR SRI LANKA

In October 2010, 10 Sri Lankan TVET participants attended a two-week course sponsored under their Technical Education Development Project. The course focused on sharing of NYP's experience in the management and development of a modern TVET institution and competency-based training. The participants came from Sri Lanka's Tertiary and Vocational Education Commission, National Apprentice and Industrial Training Authority, Department of Technical Education and Training, and the University of Vocational Technology.
